The following pharmaceutical services have been considered as other relevant services:

- **North Cumbria Integrated Care NHS Foundation Trust** provides an inpatient and outpatient pharmacy dispensing service to patients and Cumbria's population from three locations: Cumberland Infirmary, Carlisle; West Cumberland Hospital, Whitehaven; and Carleton Clinic, Carlisle. The hospital trust pharmacy also supplies medicines to North Cumbria's community hospitals and community clinics; Cumbria Health On Call (GP Out of hours service); and Cumbria Northumberland, Tyne & Wear Trust.
- **University Hospital of Morecambe Bay NHS Foundation Trust** provides an inpatient and out-patient pharmacy dispensing service to patients and Cumbria's population from two locations in Cumbria: Furness General Hospital, Barrow-in-Furness; and Westmorland General Hospital, Kendal. The Trust has a hospital located outside of Cumbria in Lancaster (The Royal Lancaster Infirmary). - **Cumbria, Northumberland, Tyne & Wear Trust** provides a range of mental health, learning disability and neurological care services across the north of England including North Cumbria CCG South Cumbria (part of Morecambe Bay CCG).
- **Lancashire & South Cumbria NHS Foundation Trust** provides health and wellbeing services including community nursing, health visiting and a range of therapy services; wellbeing services include smoking cessation and healthy lifestyle services. Public survey

Background/Method

As part of the development of the draft Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) a public survey was carried out. The consultation ran from the 14th of January 2022 to the 11th of February 2022. The survey was conducted online using Cumbria County Council’s dedicated website.

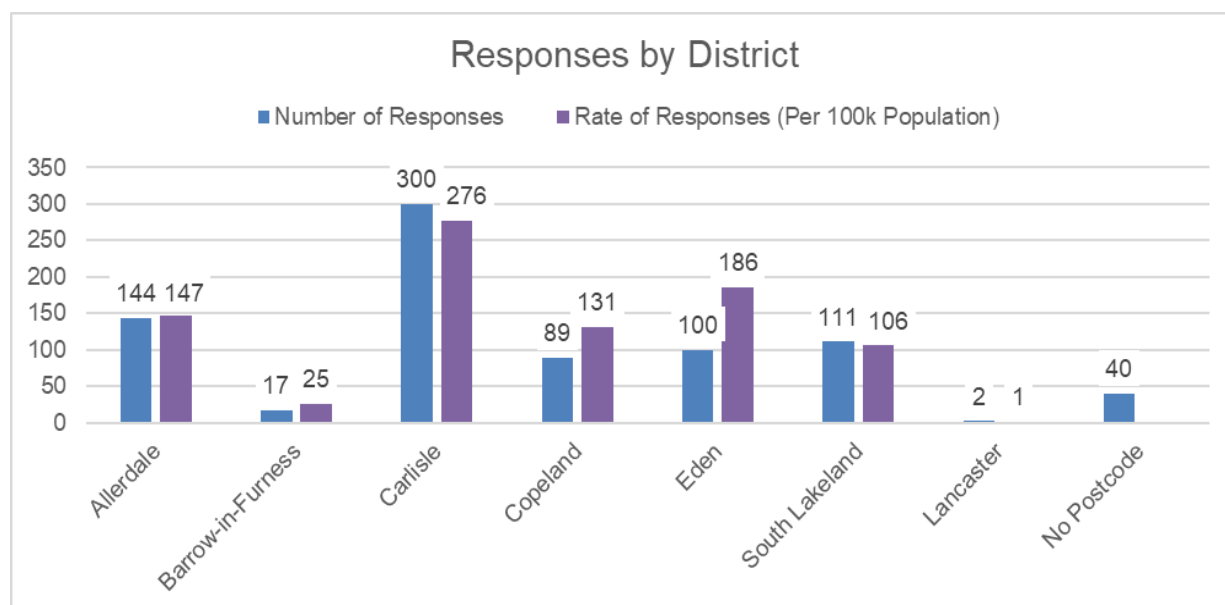
803 responses to the public survey were received. This report only summarises the responses provided by respondents regarding the services provided by their pharmacy. No attempt has been made to cross reference respondent’s opinions or perceptions against the actual services commissioned or available via their pharmacy.

Due to rounding some percentage totals in tables and charts may not add up to 100.

Geographical Profile

At district level, Carlisle accounted for both the greatest number and rate of responses (300 responses = 276 responses per 100k population). Inversely, Barrow-in-Furness accounted for the smallest number and rate of responses (17 responses = 25 responses per 100k population). Two responses were received from outside of Cumbria’s boundary, both coming from Lancaster. District level analysis has not been provided for Lancaster due to the small number of responses.

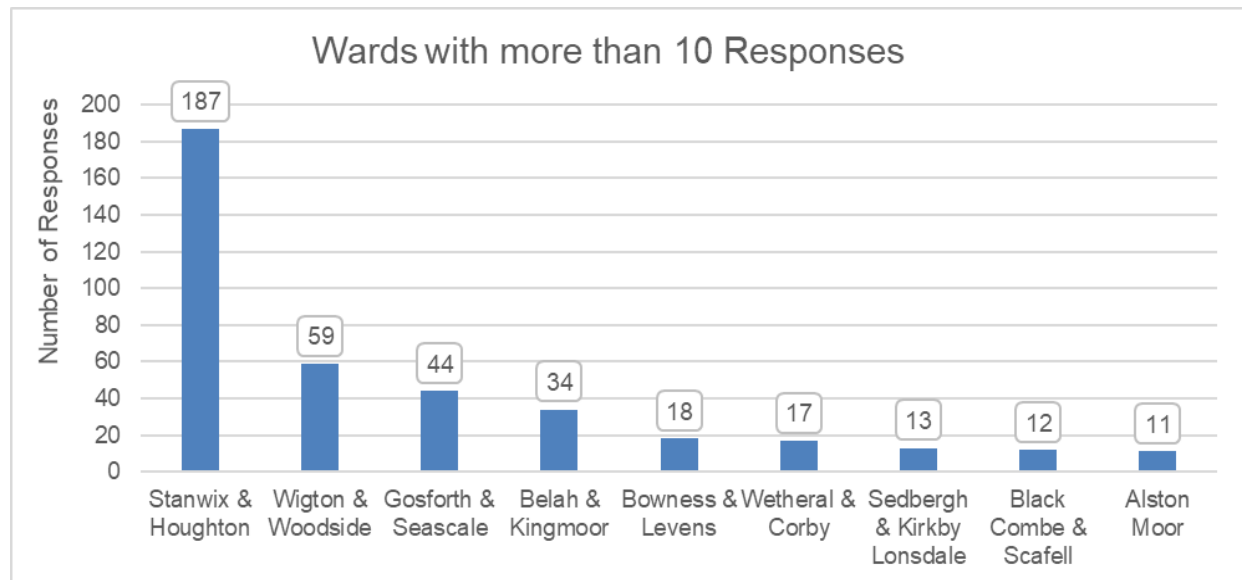
Figure 1: Respondents by District (base=803)



Appendix 6.1: Public Survey consultation

At ward level, Stanwix & Houghton ward accounted for by far the greatest number of responses (187 responses = 23% all responses). This appears to be in response to a local campaign driven by dissatisfaction with the quality of service provision from the pharmacy that is located within the ward. There were 10 wards with more than 10 responses, these wards are identified in figure 2.

Figure 2: Respondents by Ward: Wards with more than 10 Responses (base=803)

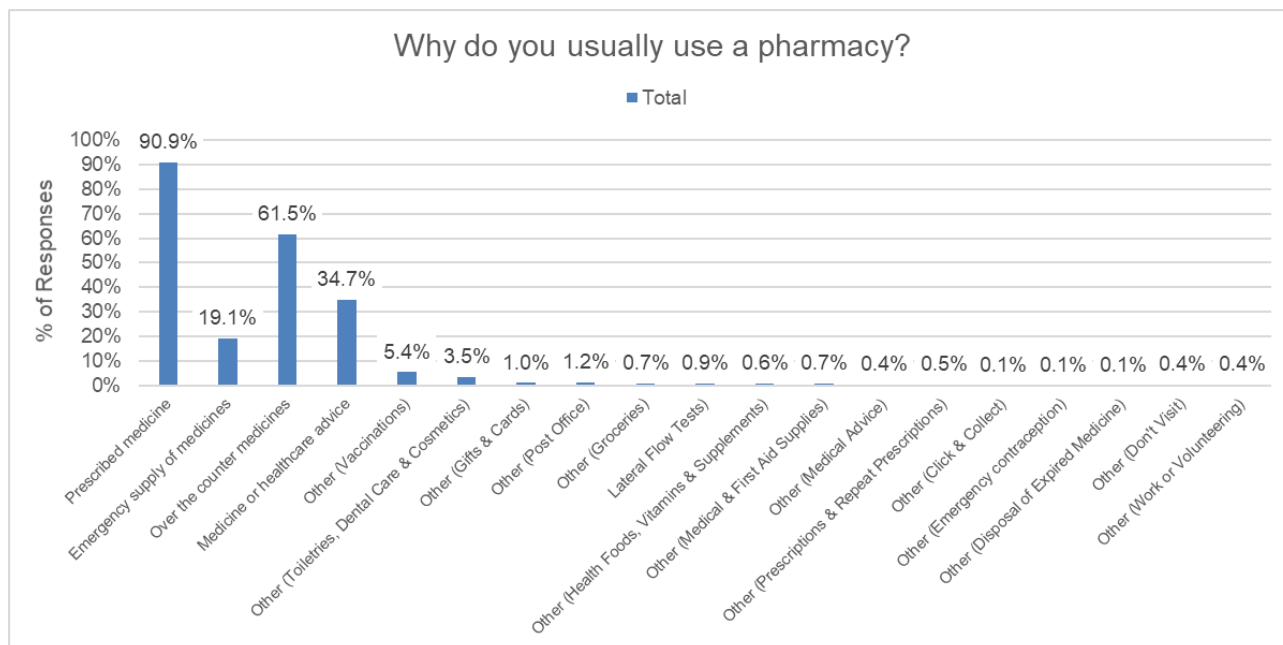


Results

Q1. Why do you usually use a pharmacy? (Tick all that apply)

The most common pharmacy use given by respondents was 'prescription medicine' (given by 91% of respondents), followed by 'over the counter medicines' (62%) and 'medicine or healthcare advice' (35%). These responses were the top three responses given in all six of Cumbria's districts, with prescription medicine being the most common response in every district except Copeland. In Copeland the most common response was over the counter medicine.

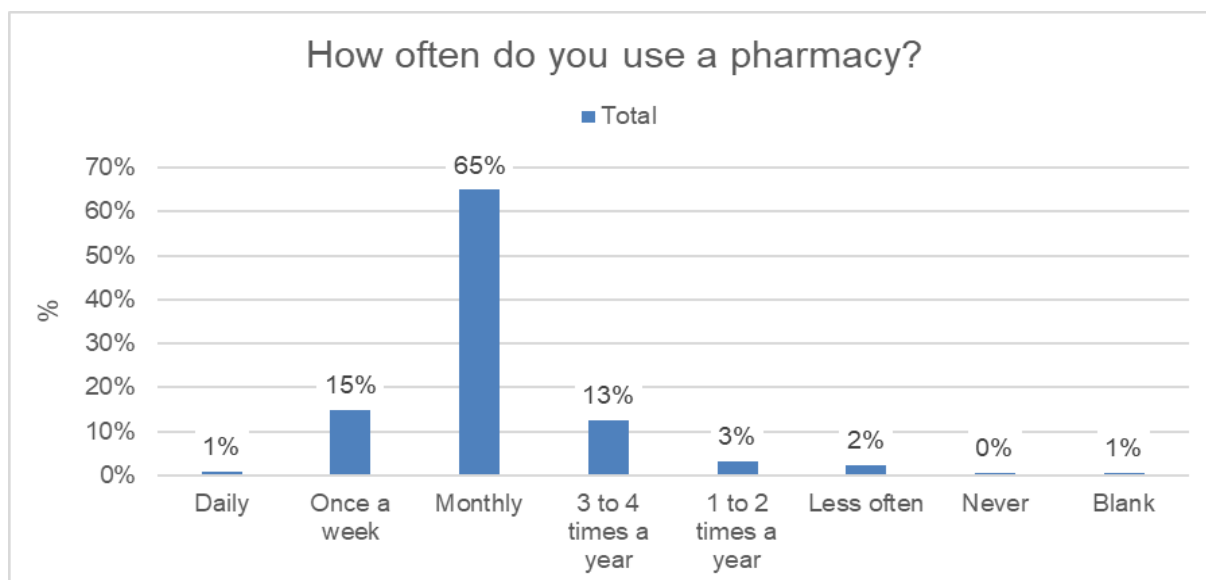
Figure 3: Why do you usually use a pharmacy?: Base 803:



Q2. How often do you use a pharmacy?

The most common frequency of use given was ‘monthly’ (65% of respondents), followed by ‘once a month’ (15%) and ‘3 to 4 times per year’ (13%). These responses were the top three responses given in all six of Cumbria’s districts, with monthly being the most common response in every district.

Figure 4: How often do you use a pharmacy?: Base = 803:

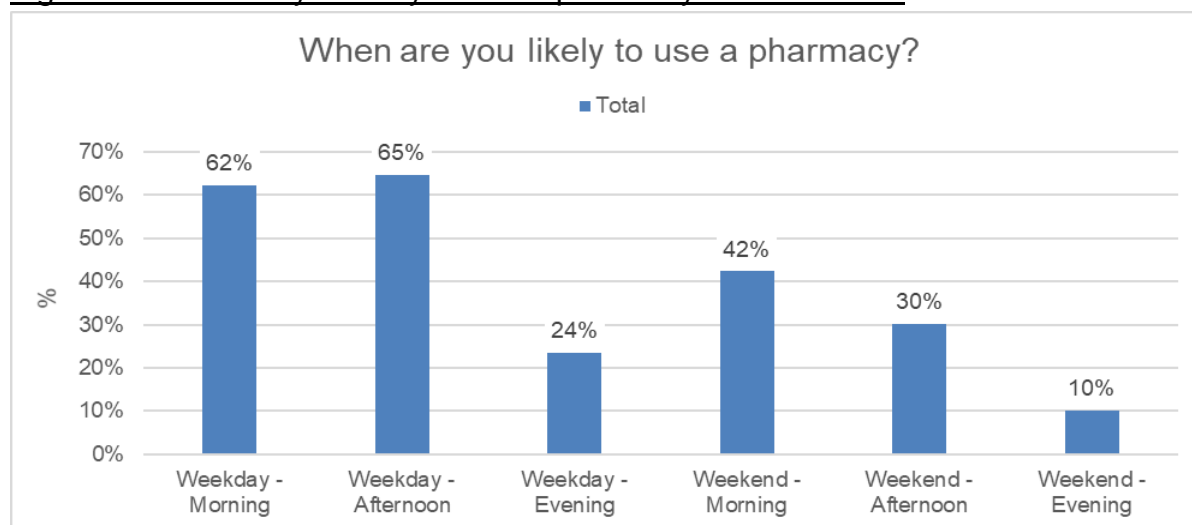


Q3. When are you likely to use a pharmacy? (Tick all that apply)

The most common time to use a pharmacy was ‘weekday afternoon’ (65% of respondents), followed by ‘weekday morning’ (62%) and ‘weekend morning’ (42%). These responses were the top three responses given in all six of Cumbria’s districts

except Barrow-in-Furness, where ‘weekend afternoon’ was the third most common response. Furthermore, weekday afternoon was the most common response in every district except Eden, where weekday morning was the most common response.

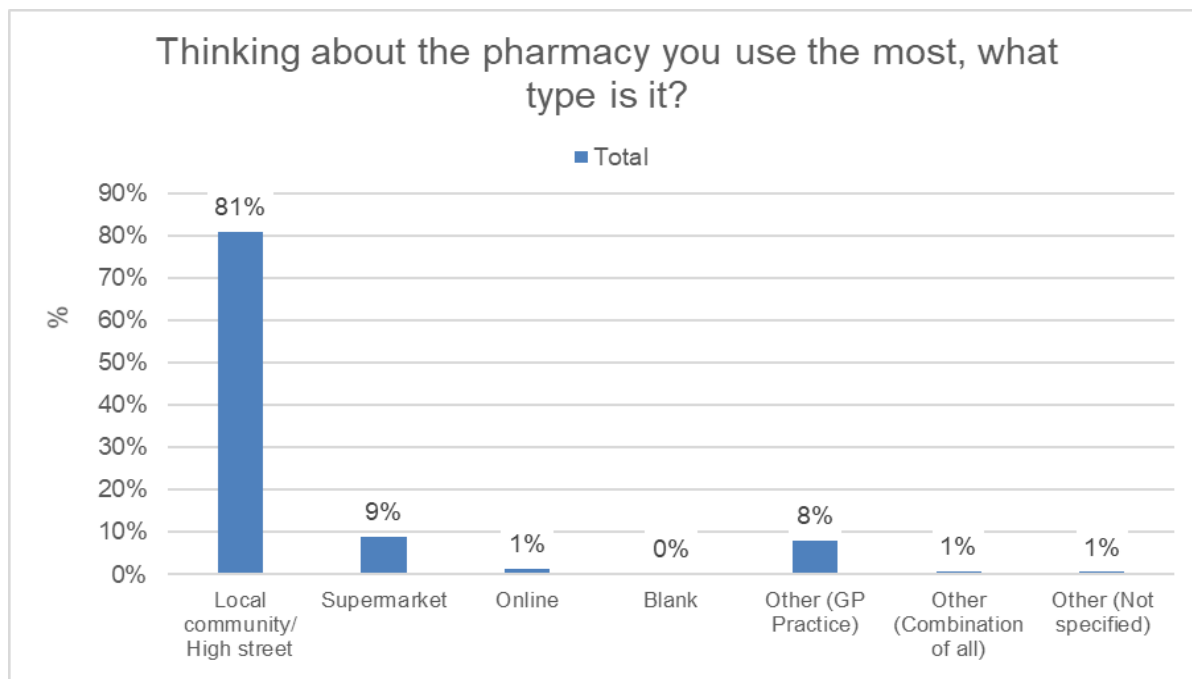
Figure 5: When are you likely to use a pharmacy?: Base = 803:



Q4. Thinking about the pharmacy you use the most, what type is it?

The most common type of pharmacy was ‘local community/high street’ (81%), followed by ‘supermarket’ (9%) and ‘other – GP Practice’ (8%). These responses were the top three responses given in Carlisle, Copeland and South Lakeland, with local community/high street being the most common response by far in every district. ‘Online’ was the third most common response in Barrow-in-Furness and the joint third most common response in South Lakeland. In Allerdale ‘other not specified’ was the third most common response, however, this accounted for just 2% of Allerdale’s responses as the vast majority of responses in Allerdale related to local community/high street (91%).

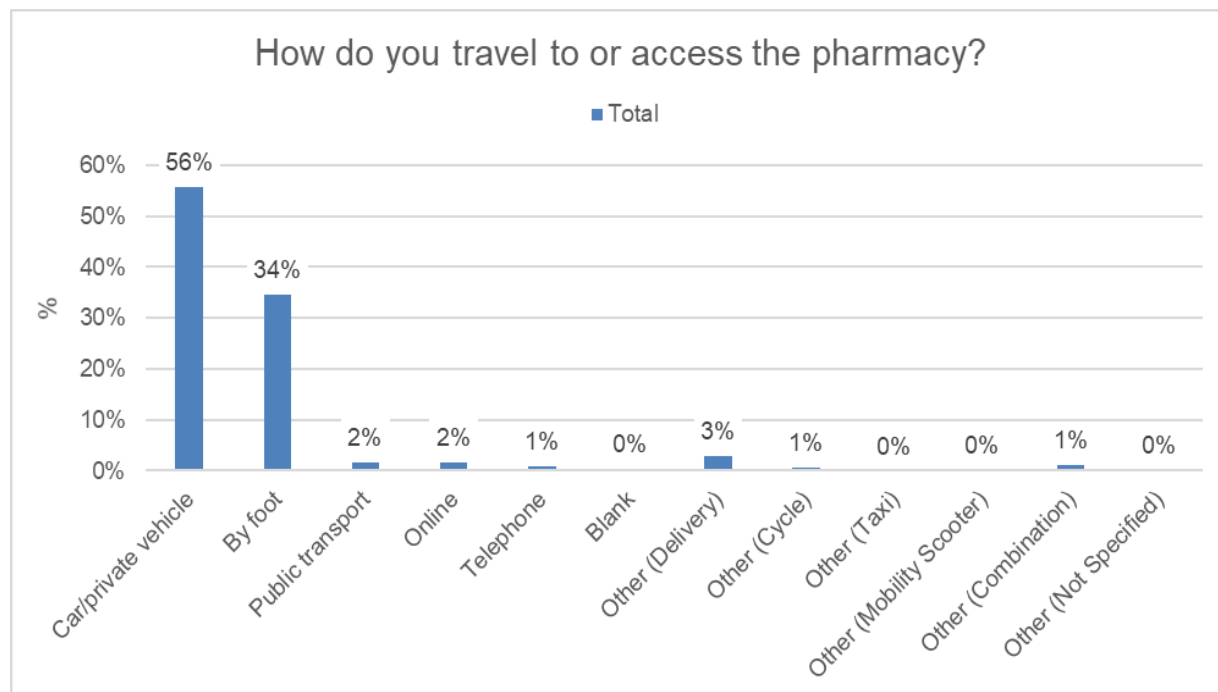
Figure 6: When are you likely to use a pharmacy?: Base = 803:



Q5. How do you travel to or access the pharmacy?

The most common mode of transport to a pharmacy was ‘car/private vehicle’ (56%), followed by ‘by foot’ (34%), with other responses accounting for very small proportions of responses. Car/private vehicle was the most common response in all districts and by foot was the second most common response in all districts. However, across the districts, Barrow-in-Furness had the highest proportion of car/private vehicle responses (76%) while Carlisle had the lowest proportion of this response (45%). Inversely, Carlisle had the highest proportion of by foot responses (44%) while Barrow-in-Furness had the lowest proportion of this response (18%).

Figure 7: How do you travel to or access the pharmacy?: Base = 803:



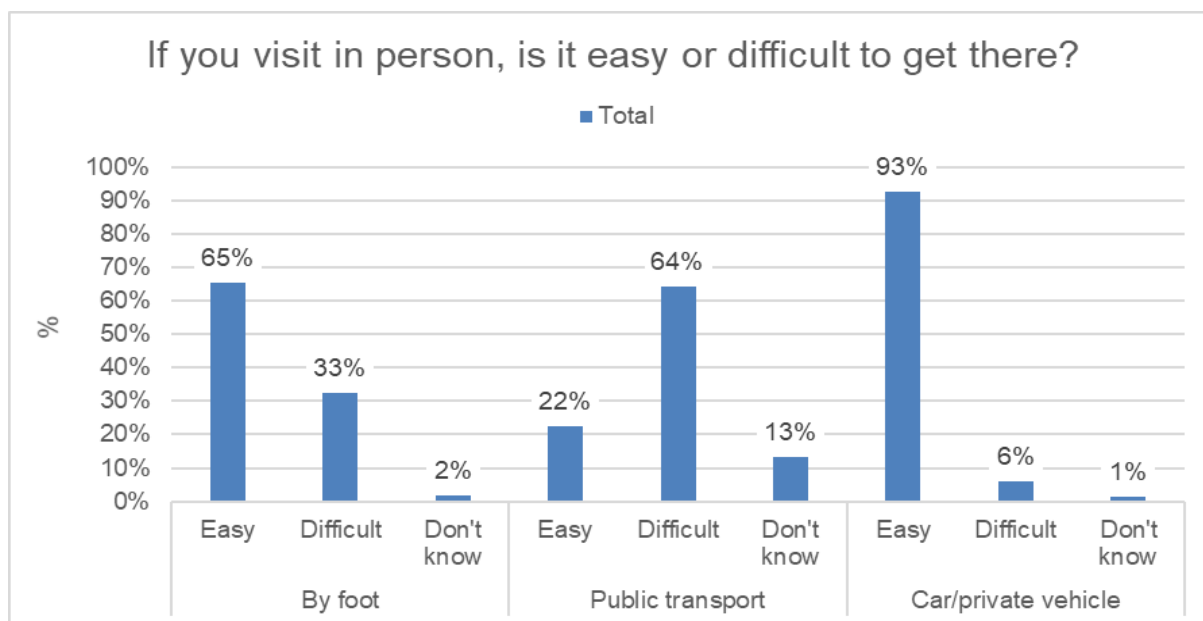
Q6. If you visit in person, is it easy or difficult to get there?

Of the 610 respondents who provided answers regarding travel by car/private vehicle, by far the greatest proportion (93%) reported that access was ‘easy’. The greatest proportion of respondents reported that travel by car/private vehicle was easy in all districts. Across the districts, Allerdale had the greatest proportion of respondents reporting that travel by car/private vehicle was ‘difficult’ (8%).

Of the 568 respondents who provided answers regarding travel by foot, the greatest proportion (65%) reported that access was ‘easy’. The greatest proportion of respondents reported that travel by foot was easy in all districts except Eden. In Eden the greatest proportion of respondents (52%) reported that travel by foot was ‘difficult’.

Of the 322 respondents who provided answers regarding travel by public transport, the greatest proportion (64%) reported that access was ‘difficult’. The greatest proportion of respondents reported that travel by public transport was difficult in all districts. Across the districts, Eden had the greatest proportion of respondents reporting that travel by public transport was ‘difficult’ (88%).

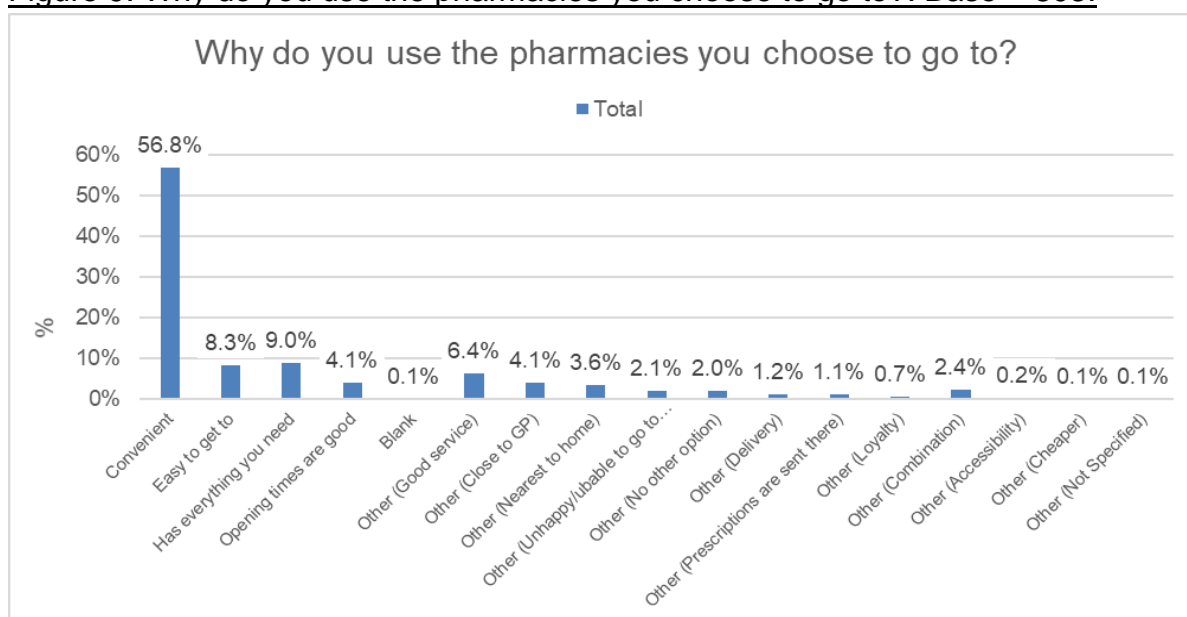
Figure 8: If you visit in person, is it easy or difficult to get there?: Base By Foot = 568, Base Public Transport = 322, Base Car/Private Vehicle = 610:



Q7. Why do you use the pharmacies you choose to go to?

The most response by far to this question was ‘convenient’ (57%), followed by ‘has everything you need’ (9%) and ‘easy to get to’ (8%), with other responses accounting for very small proportions of responses. Convenient was the most common response in all districts, however there was some variation in the second and third most common responses. Most notably, in Allerdale and South Lakeland ‘other - good service’ accounted for the second most common responses (15% and 12% respectively), while in Barrow-in-Furness ‘opening times are good’ and ‘other – close to GP’ accounted for the joint third most common responses (both 12%).

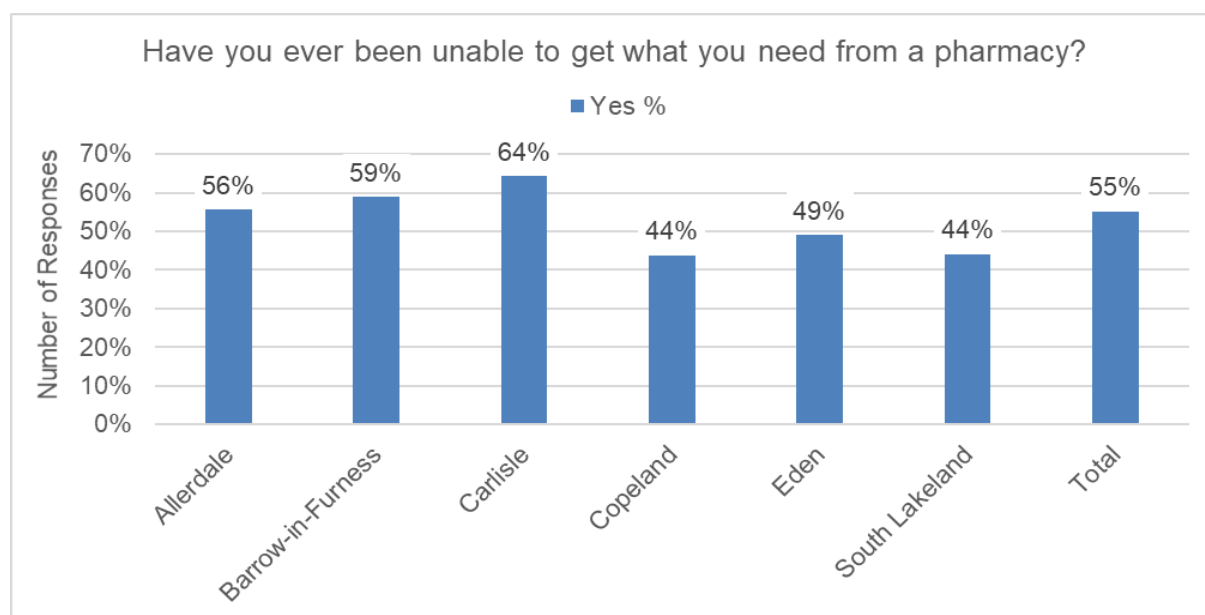
Figure 9: Why do you use the pharmacies you choose to go to?: Base = 803:



Q8. Have you ever been unable to get what you need from a pharmacy?

The greatest proportion of respondents (55%) reported ‘yes’ (they had been unable to get what they needed from a pharmacy). ‘Yes’ was the most common response in Allerdale, Barrow-in-Furness and Carlisle. However, in Copeland and South Lakeland the greatest proportion of respondents reported ‘no’, and in Eden the number of yes and no responses were equal. Across the districts, Carlisle had the greatest proportion of respondents reporting yes, they had been unable to get what they needed from a pharmacy (64%).

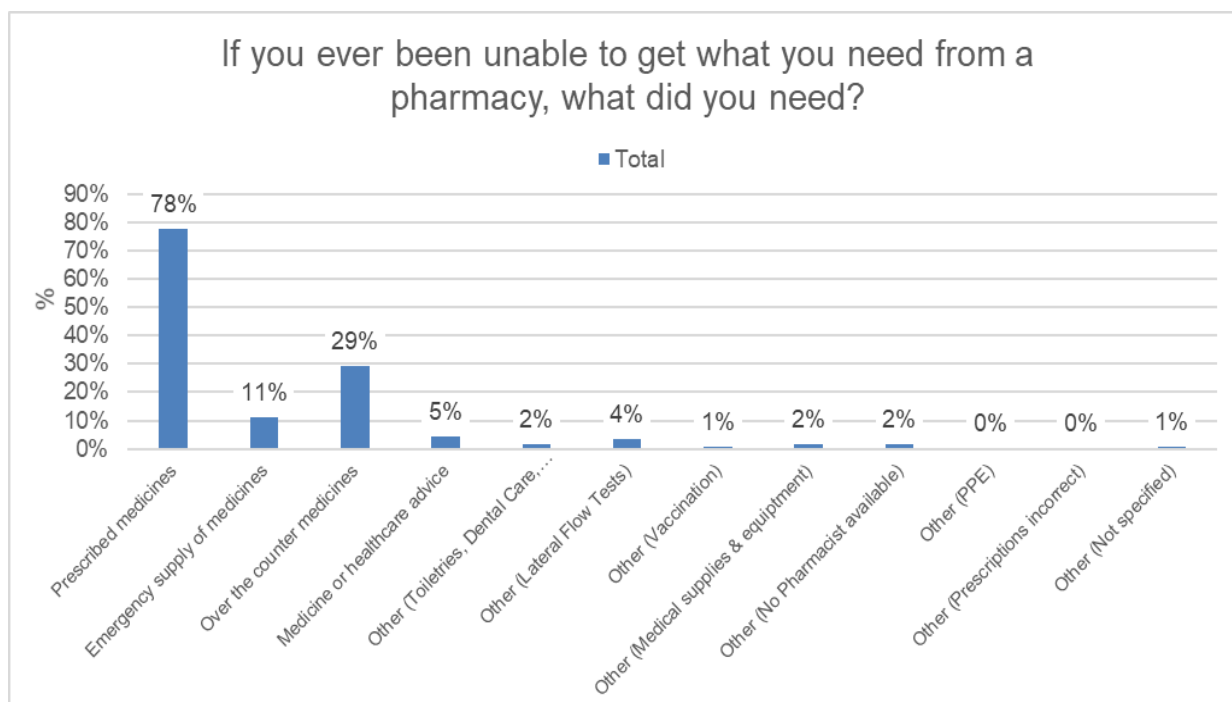
Figure 10: How do you travel to or access the pharmacy?: Base = 803:



Q9. If you ever been unable to get what you need from a pharmacy, what did you need? (Tick all that apply)

Of the 443 respondents who reported that ‘yes’ they had been unable to get what they need from a pharmacy, by far the greatest proportion (78%) reported that they needed ‘prescribed medicine’, followed by ‘over the counter medicine’ (29%) and then ‘emergency supply of medicine’ (11%). Prescribed medicine was the most common response in all districts with the above responses being the top three responses given in all districts with a small number of exceptions; in Barrow-in-Furness ‘medicine or healthcare advice’ was the third most common response (20%), in Copeland ‘other – lateral flow tests’ was the third most common response (8%) and in Eden ‘other – medical supplies & equipment’ was the third most common response (8%). Across districts, Carlisle had the greatest proportion of respondents reporting prescribed medicine (88%).

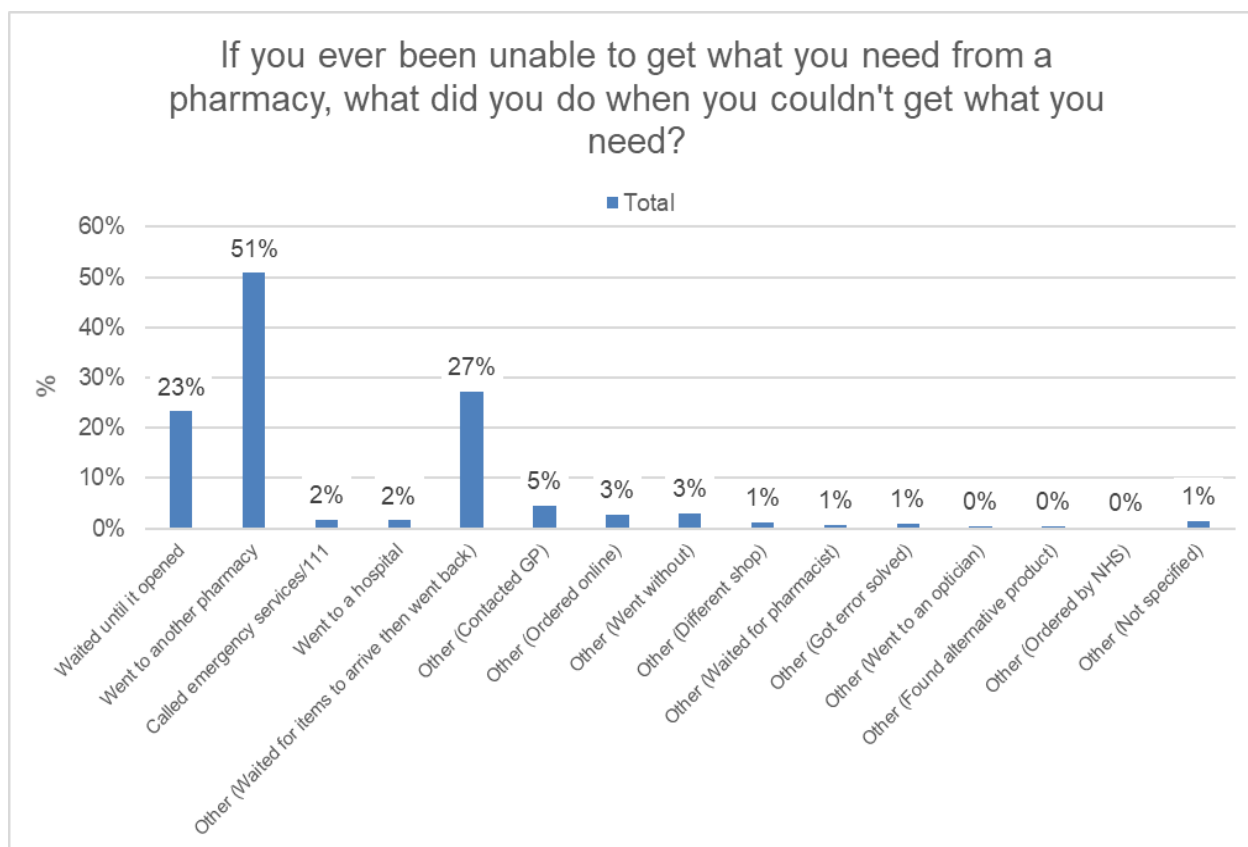
Figure 11: If you ever been unable to get what you need from a pharmacy, what did you need?: Base = 443:



Q10. If you ever been unable to get what you need from a pharmacy, what did you do when you couldn't get what you need?

Of the 443 respondents who reported that 'yes' they had been unable to get what they need from a pharmacy, the greatest proportion (51%) reported that they 'went to another pharmacy', followed by 'other – waited for items to arrive then went back' (27%) and then 'waited until it opened' (23%). 'Went to another pharmacy' was the most common response in all districts while the above responses were the top three responses given in all districts except Barrow-in-Furness. In Barrow-in-Furness 'other – contacted GP' and 'other – ordered online' were the joint third most common responses (both 10%).

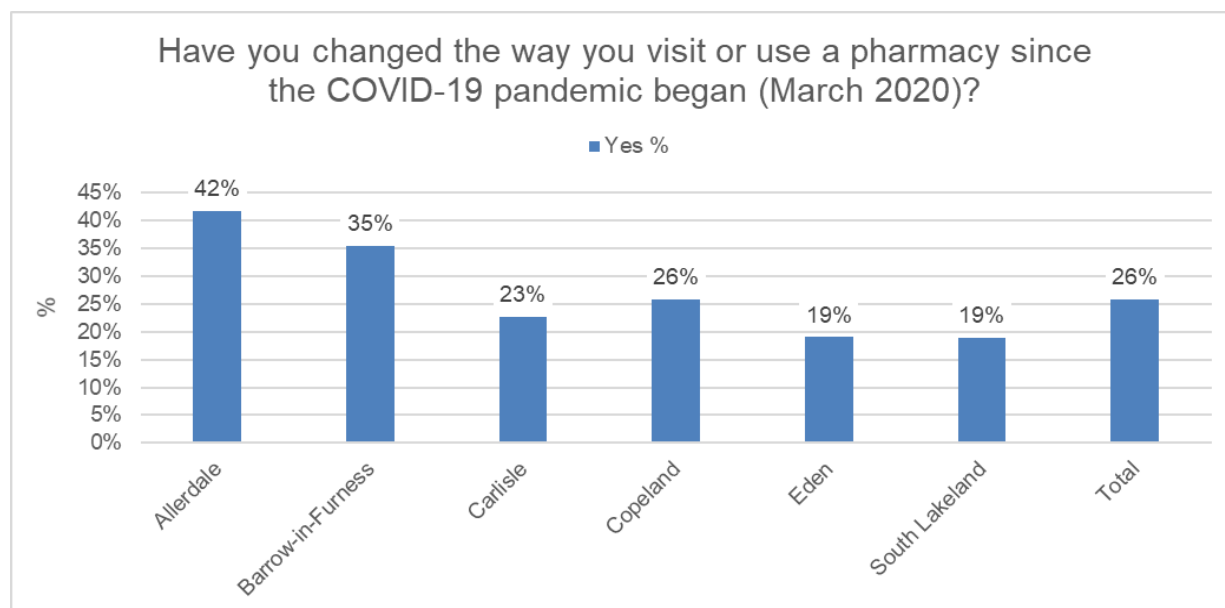
Figure 12: If you ever been unable to get what you need from a pharmacy, what did you do when you couldn't get what you need?: Base = 443:



Q11. Have you changed the way you visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began (March 2020)?

The greatest proportion of respondents (73%) reported 'no' (they had not changed the way they visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began). 'No' was the most common response in all districts. Across the districts, Allerdale had the greatest proportion of respondents reporting 'yes' (42% reported they had changed the way they visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began).

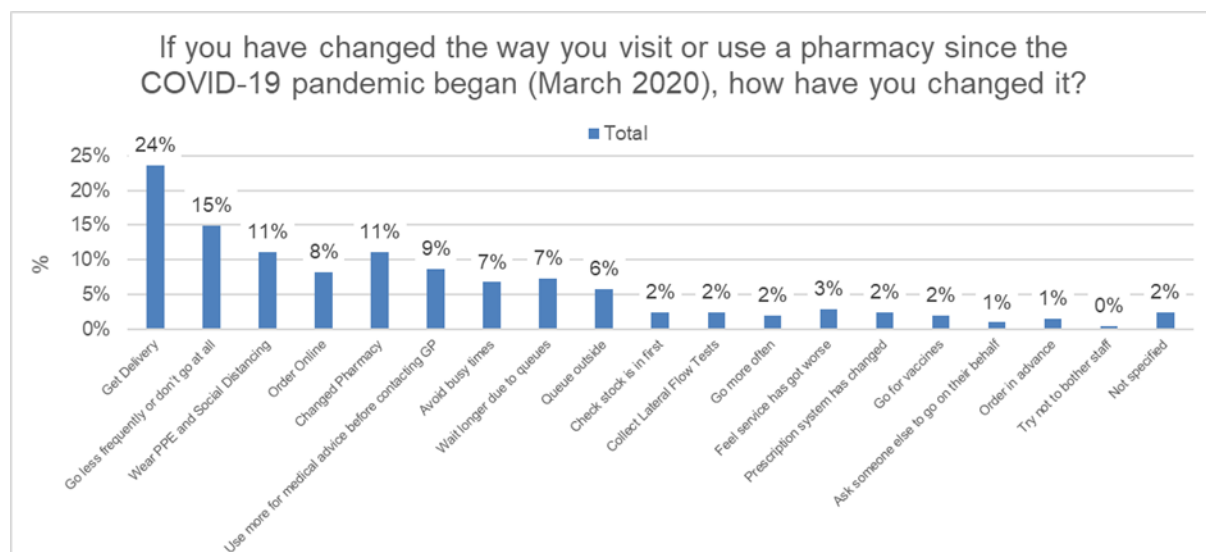
Figure 13: Have you changed the way you visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began (March 2020)? Base = 803:



Q12. If you have changed the way you visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began (March 2020), how have you changed it?

Of the 207 respondents who reported ‘yes’ (they had changed the way they visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began), the greatest proportion reported they had changed to ‘get delivery’ of their pharmacy products (24%). There was some variation in responses at a district level. In Allerdale ‘get delivery’ was the top response (47%), while in Copeland ‘get delivery’ was the joint top response alongside ‘go less frequently / don’t go at all’ and ‘wear PPE / observe social distancing’ (all 17%), and in Eden ‘get delivery’ was the joint top response alongside ‘order online’ (both 21%). In Barrow-in-Furness the greatest proportion of responses related to having ‘changed pharmacy’ (33%), while in Carlisle the top responses related to ‘waiting longer due to queues’ (16%) and in South Lakeland ‘go less frequently / don’t go at all’ was the top response (29%).

Figure 14: If you have changed the way you visit or use a pharmacy since the COVID-19 pandemic began (March 2020), how have you changed it?: Base = 207:



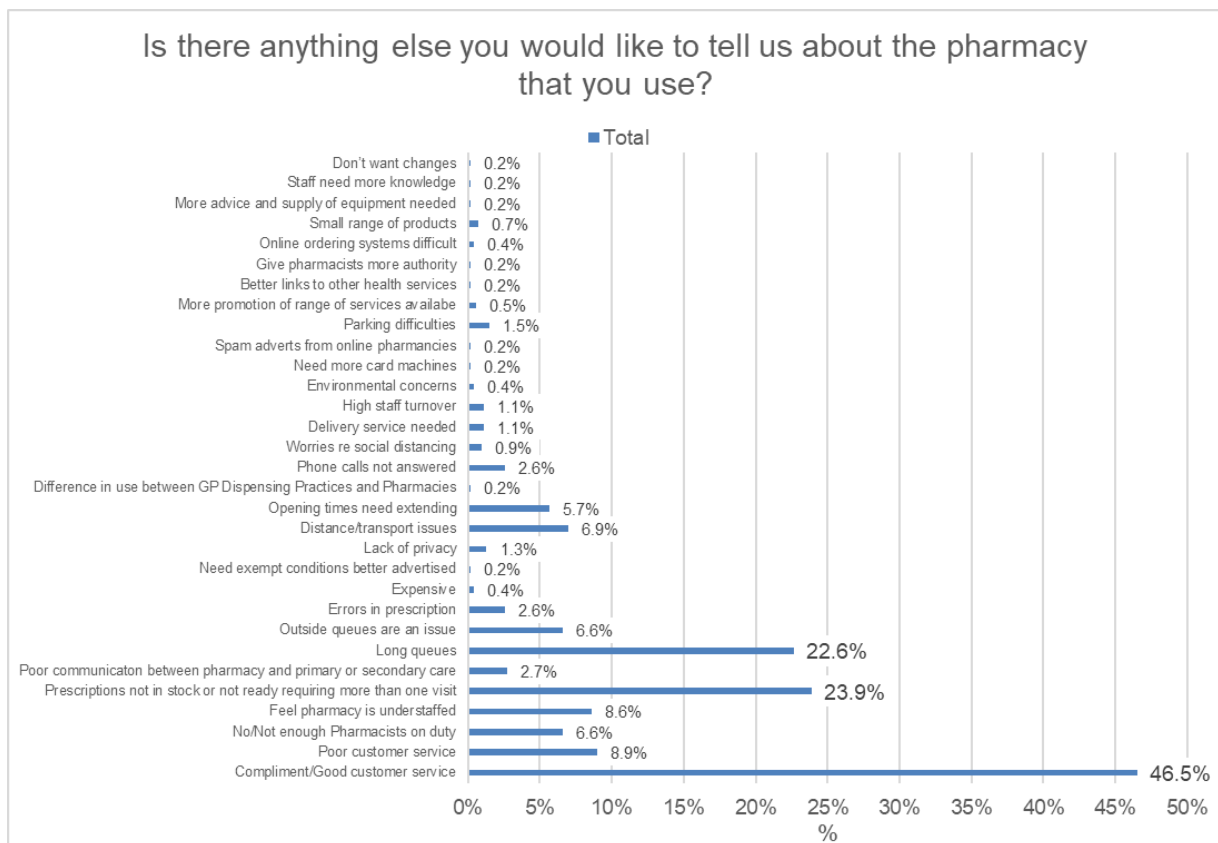
Q13. Is there anything else you would like to tell us about the pharmacy that you use?

Of the 548 respondents who provided further comments, the greatest proportion provided comments relating to 'compliments/good customer service' (47%). Comments relating to 'compliments/good customer service' accounted for the greatest proportion of comments in all districts except Carlisle. In Carlisle the greatest proportion of comments related to 'long queues' (42%). Across the districts, Copeland had the greatest proportion of comments relating to 'compliments/good customer service' (86%).

Comments relating to 'prescriptions being out of stock or not ready, requiring more than one visit' accounted for the second greatest proportion of comments (24%). This theme accounted for the second greatest proportion of comments in all districts except Copeland and Eden. Across the districts, Carlisle had the greatest proportion of comments relating to 'prescriptions being out of stock or not ready, requiring more than one visit' (35%). In Copeland comments relating to 'distance/transport issues' accounted for the second greatest proportion of comments (5%), while in Eden comments relating to 'long queues' accounted for the second greatest proportion of comments (14%).

Contractor Survey

The Contractor Survey for the Cumbria Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment was open during 13th December 2021 to 7th February 2022 (extended from 17th January), hosted on the PharmOutcomes website. There were 42 responses accounting for 40% of pharmacies across Cumbria; a district breakdown of responses is presented in the table and summary below.

For the PNA analysis, all information provided by Pharmacies has been considered at District level, however, due to confidentiality the following summary is available at Cumbria level only.

Please note that the services listed below are in addition to the services already detailed in the PNA and other Appendices.

Advanced Services

A small number of pharmacies reported providing some of the services listed below, however, many pharmacies reported that they would be willing to provide these:

- Hep C Testing (until end of March 2022).
- Hypertension case finding
- On demand availability of specialist drugs
- Sexual health - Chlamydia testing
- Substance misuse - Take Home Naloxone Service

A small number of pharmacies reported providing COVID-19 vaccinations; while almost all pharmacies responding reported they are providing Lateral Flow Testing.

- HPV vaccinations
- Travel vaccinations

Collection and delivery services

The majority of pharmacies reported offering collections of prescriptions from surgeries. Some but not all pharmacies report providing delivery services for dispensed medicines, however, some do provide this service to vulnerable patients and to surrounding rural areas. The majority of pharmacies reported providing MDS (Medication Discharge Service).

Languages

Very few pharmacies reported languages other than English being spoken in the pharmacy, however, the small number that did report other languages included: German, Lao; Mandarin; Arabic; Punjabi; Urdu and Polish.

Very few pharmacies reported other languages being spoken by the community their pharmacies serve, however, the small number that did report other languages included: various Eastern European languages; Polish; Spanish; Portuguese; Romanian; and Mandarin.

Very few pharmacies reported using a translation service as this is often not timely enough.

Workforce planning

Most pharmacies reported that they currently have sufficient workforce to meet demand; and that they are managing capacity. A small number reported they do not.

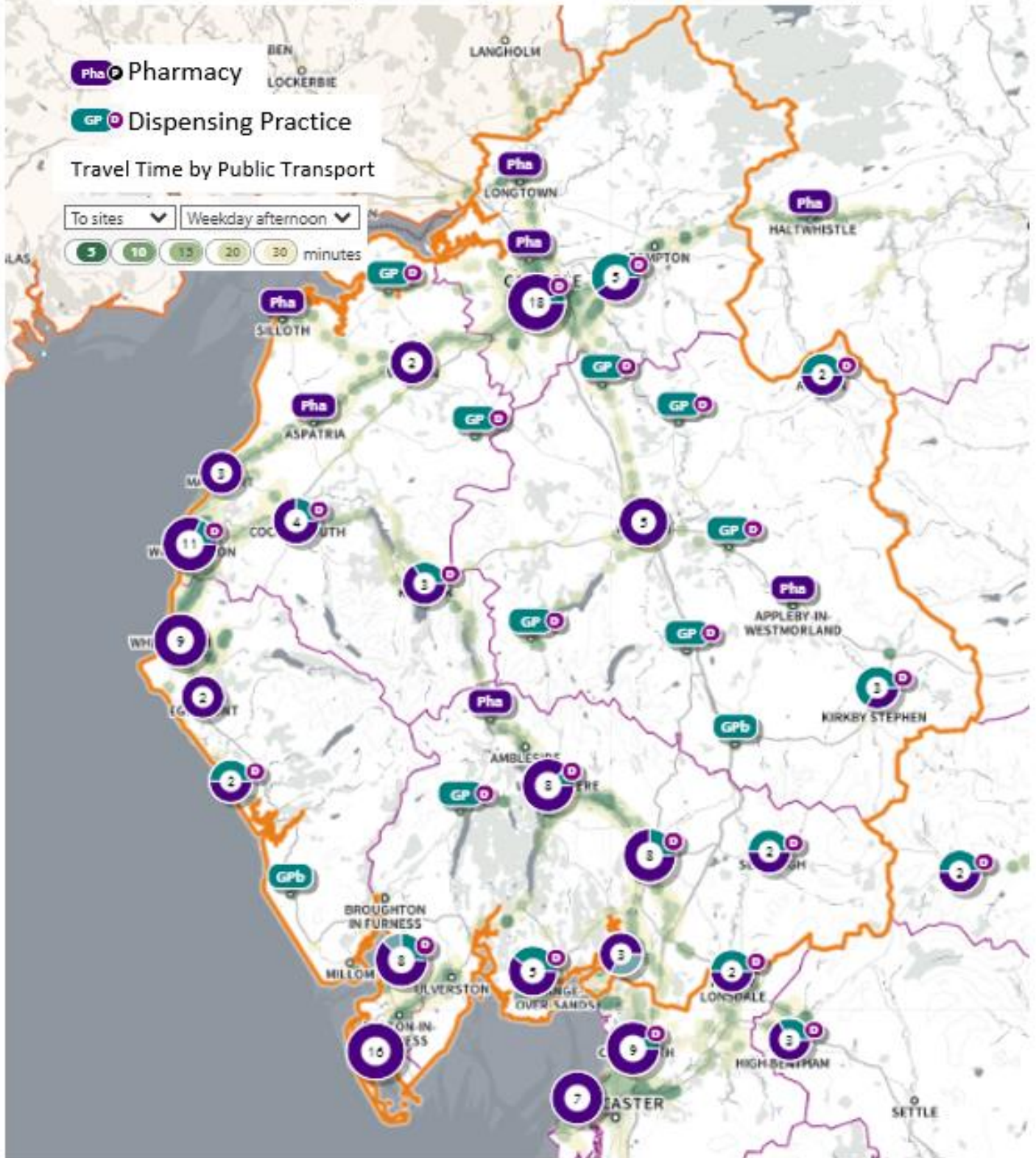

Cumbria (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Public Transport Times

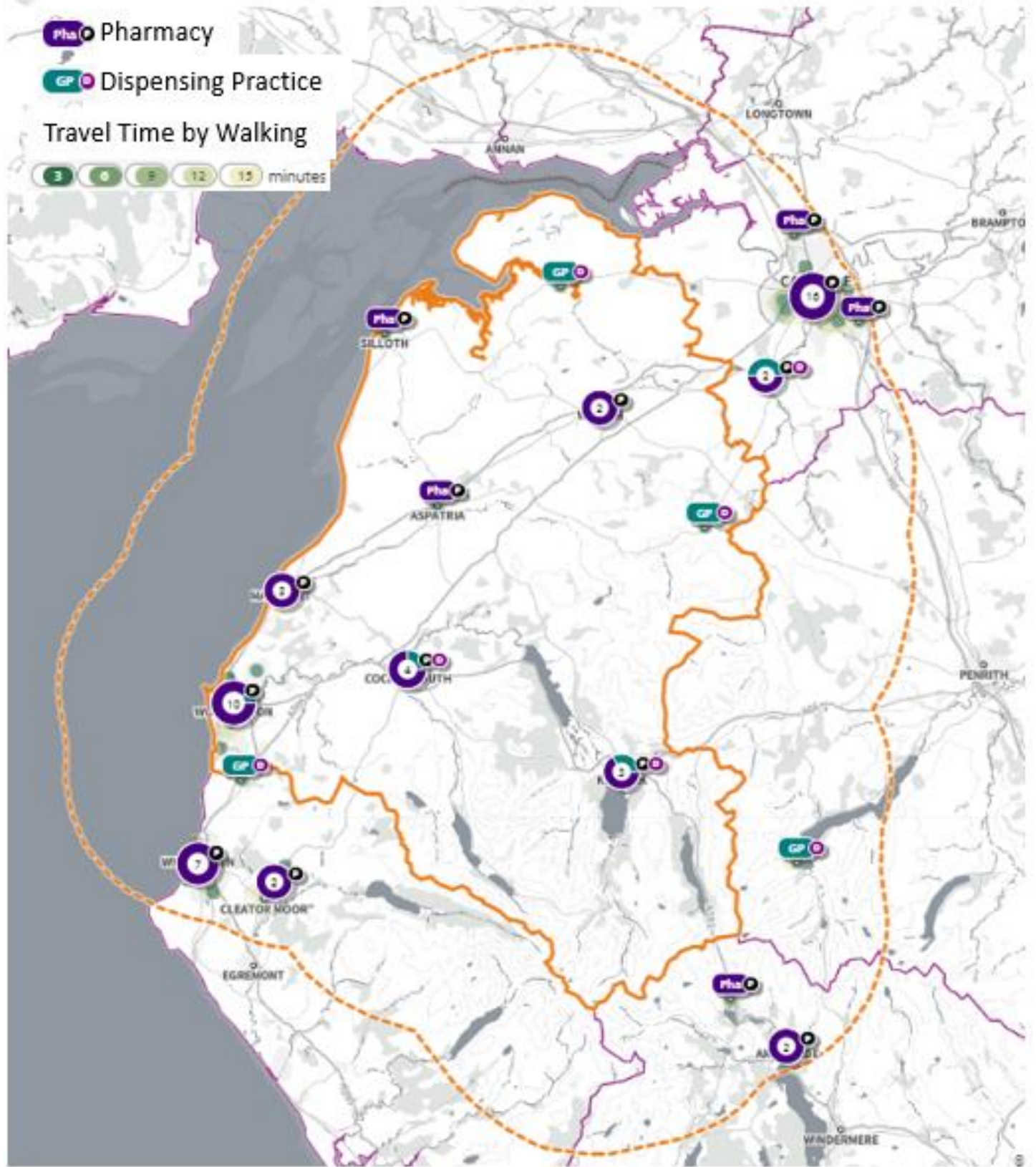


Allerdale (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Drive Times

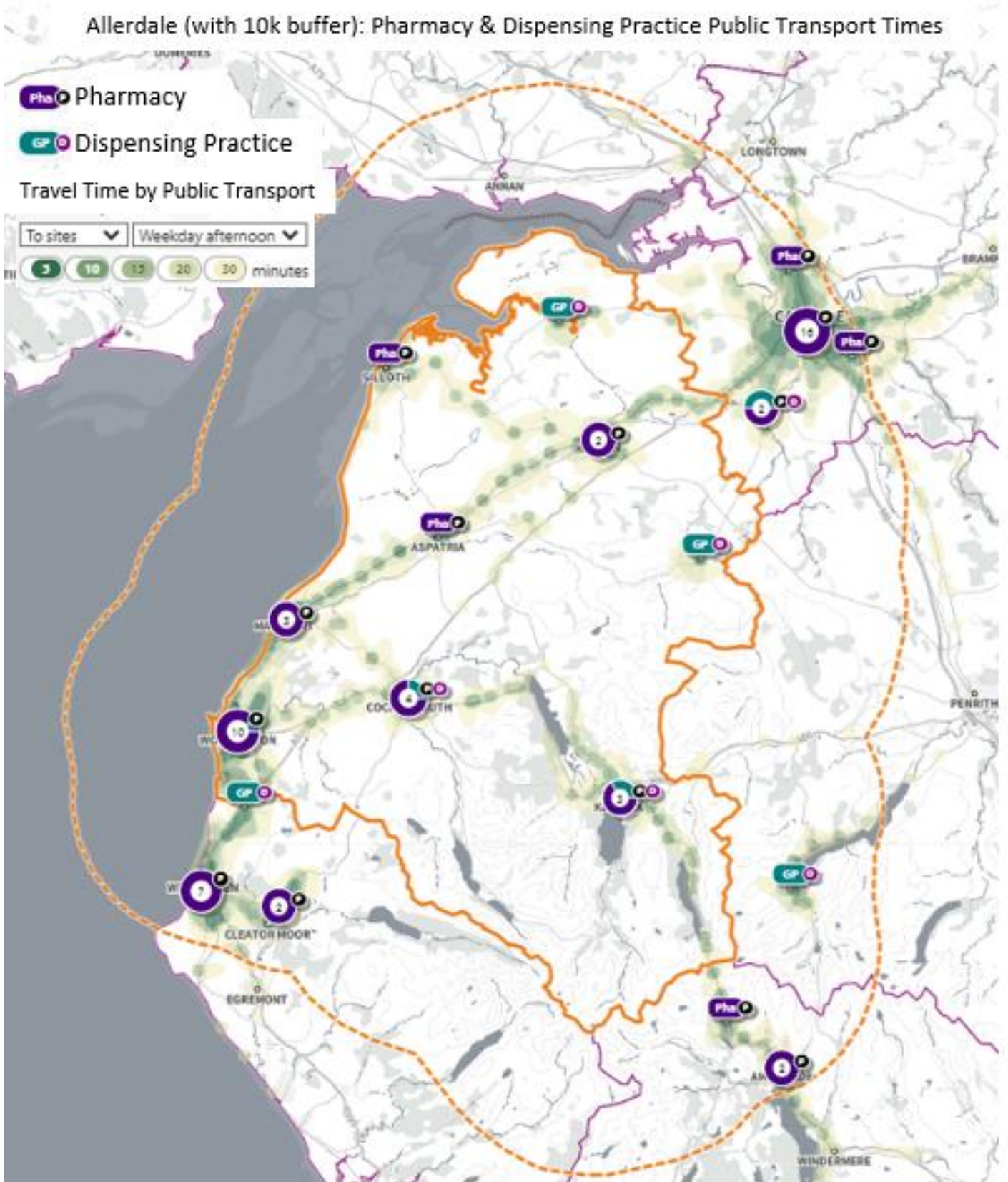

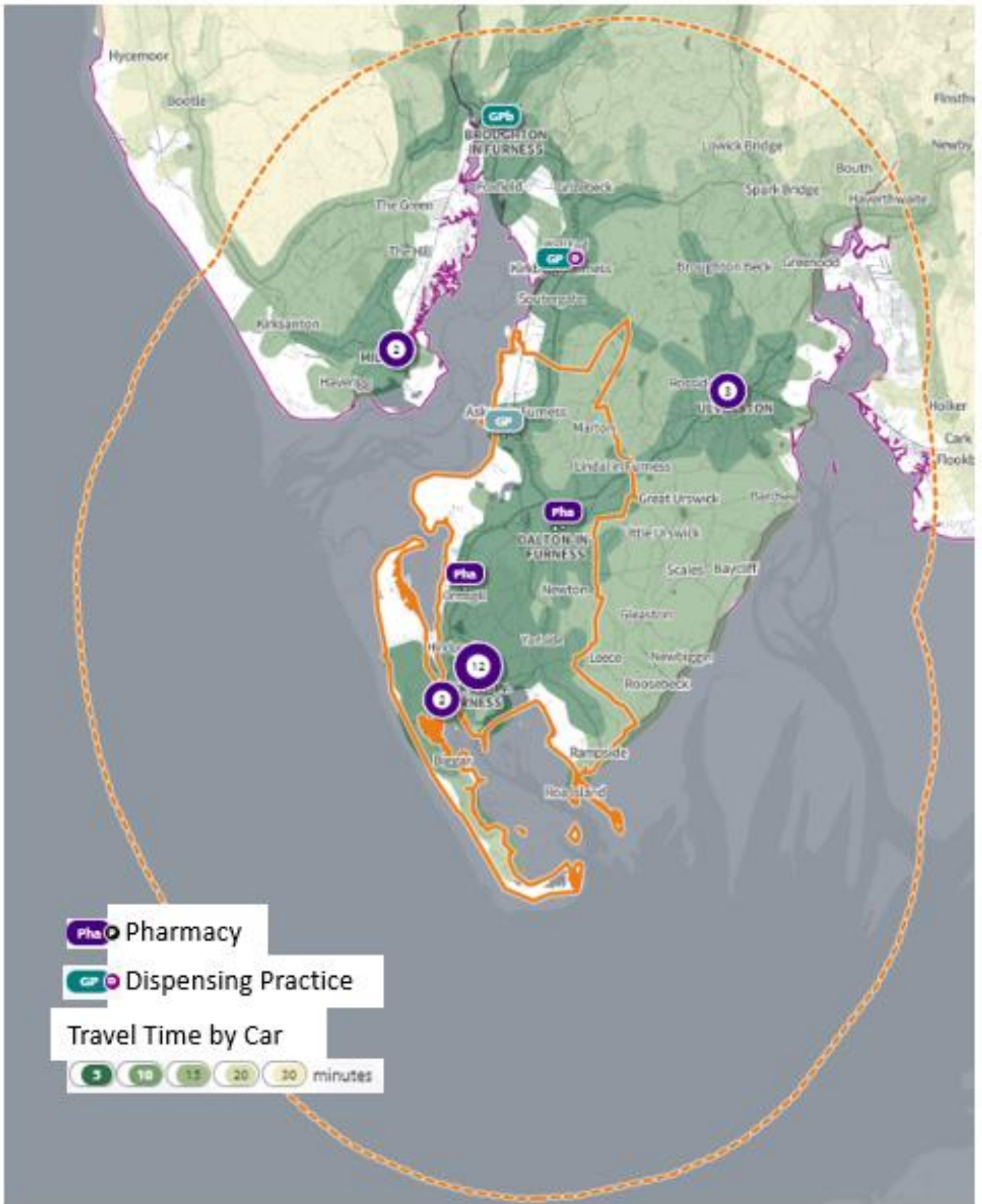
Allerdale (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Walking Times



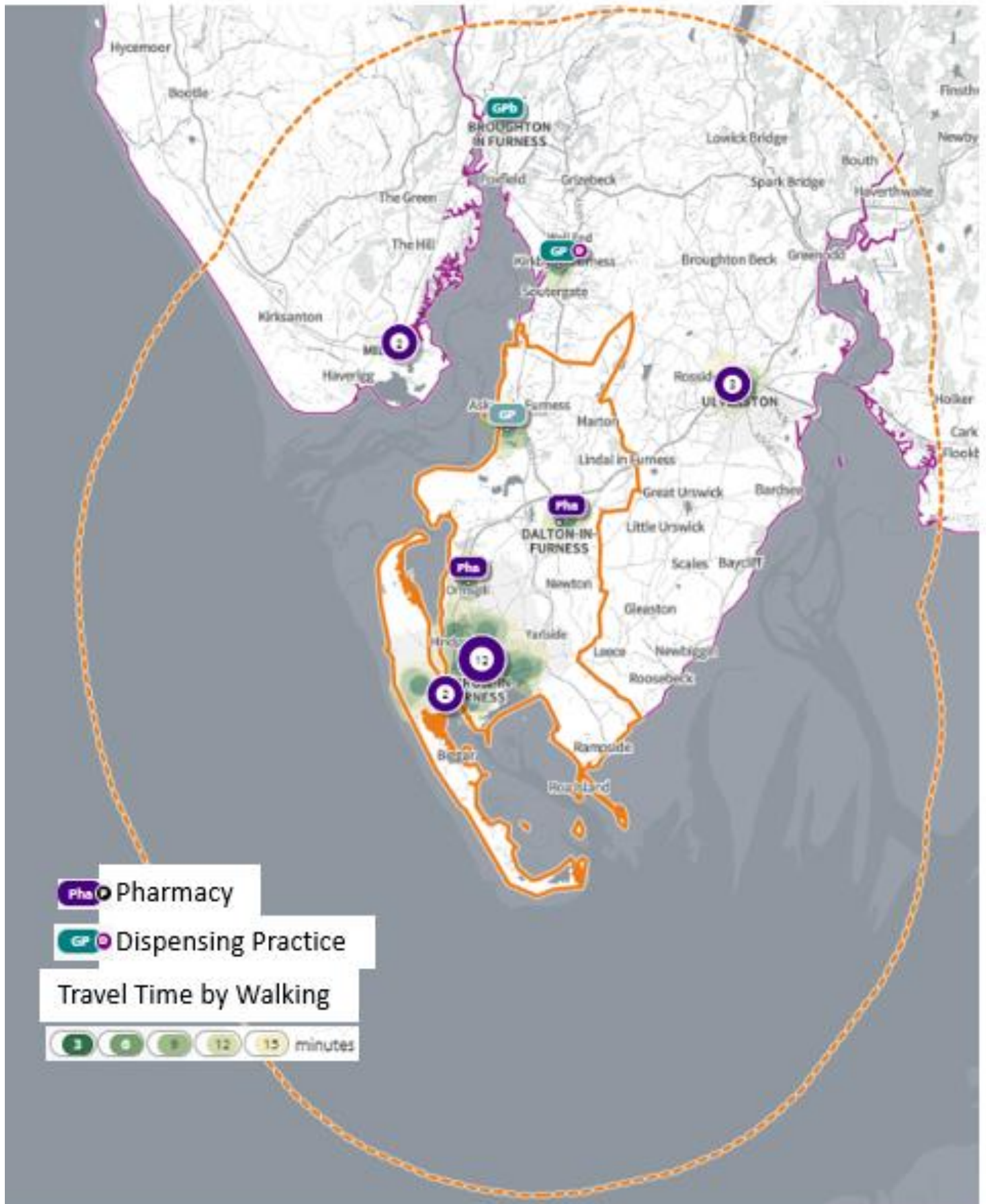

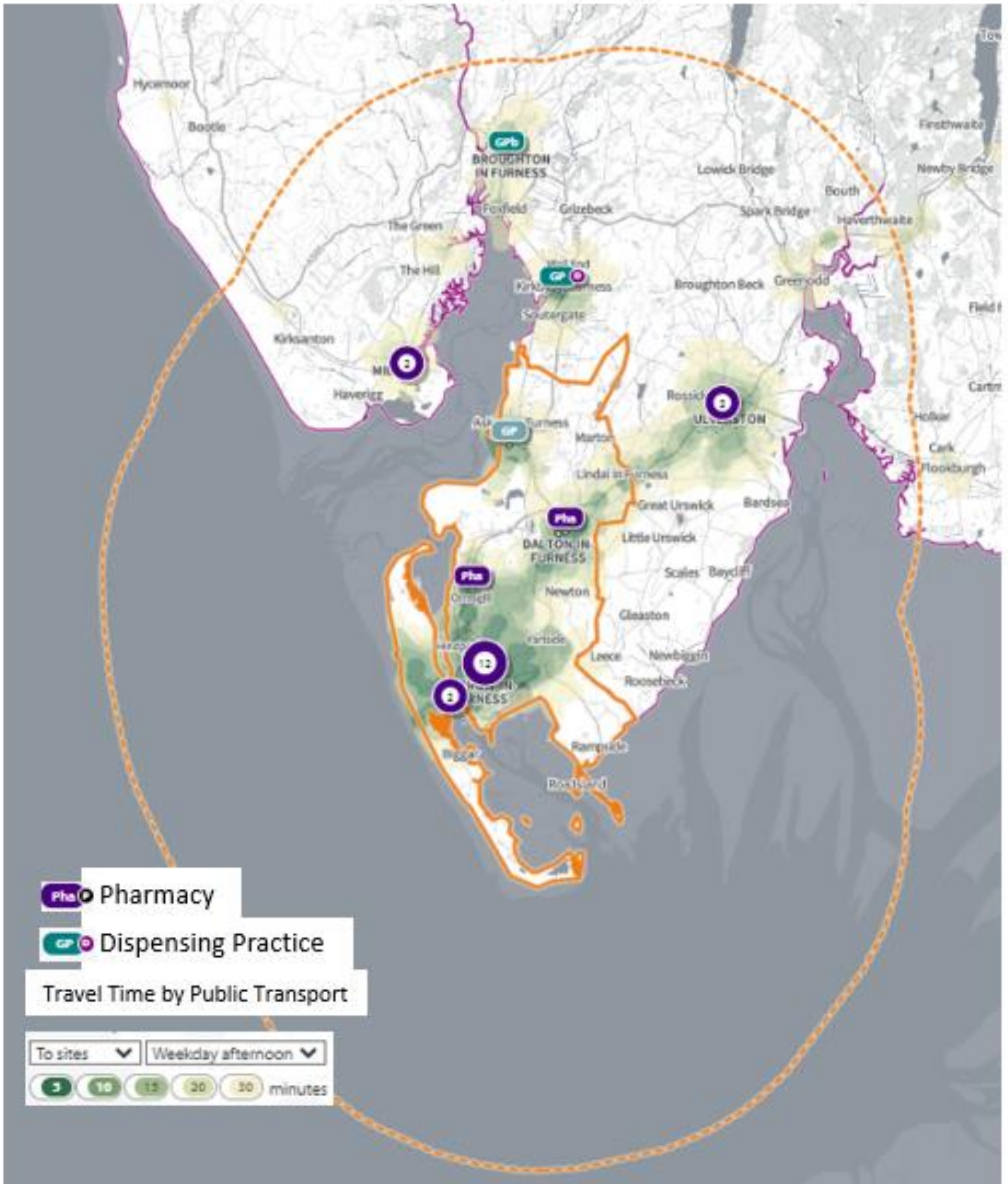
Barrow-in-Furness (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Drive Times



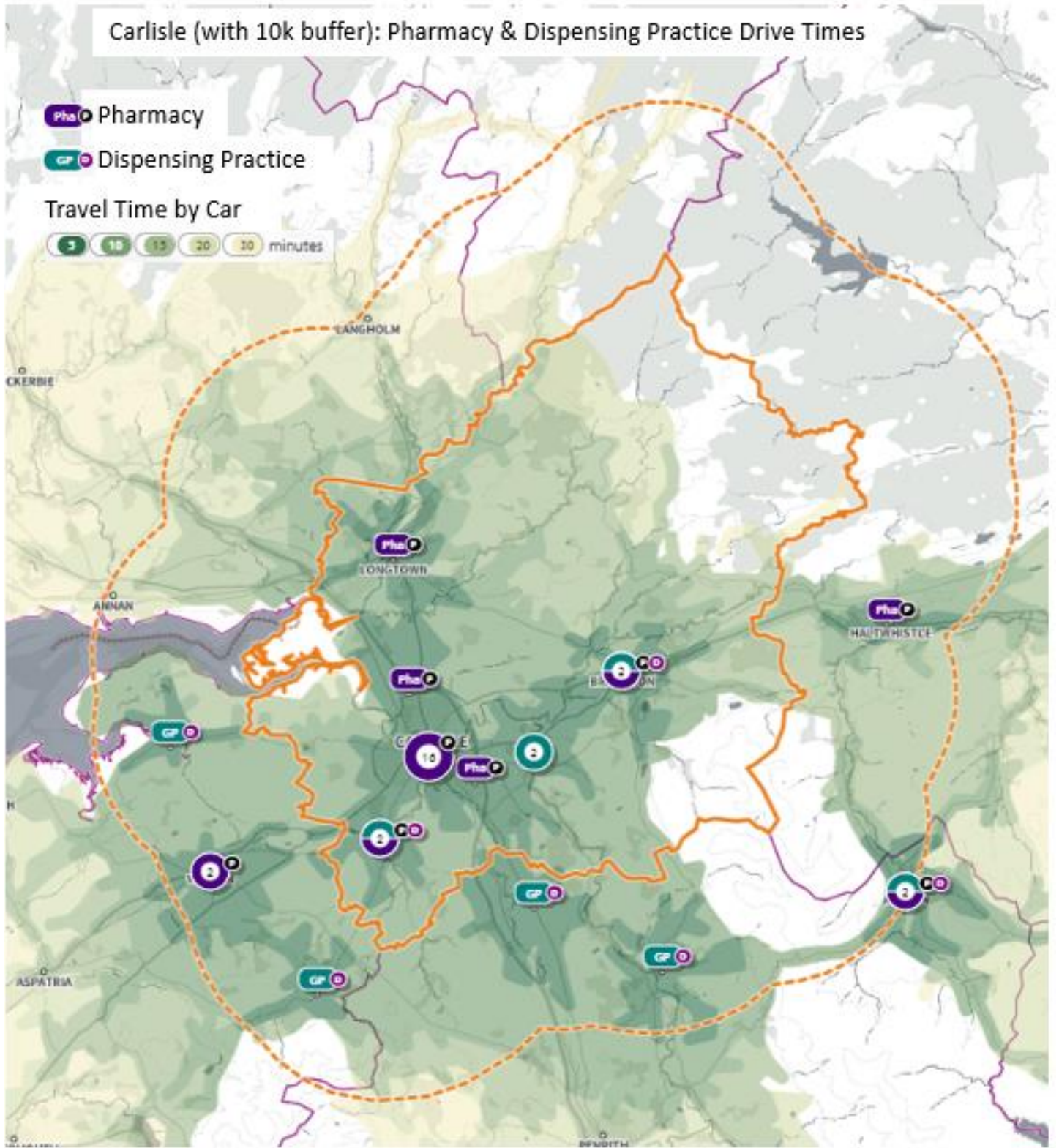

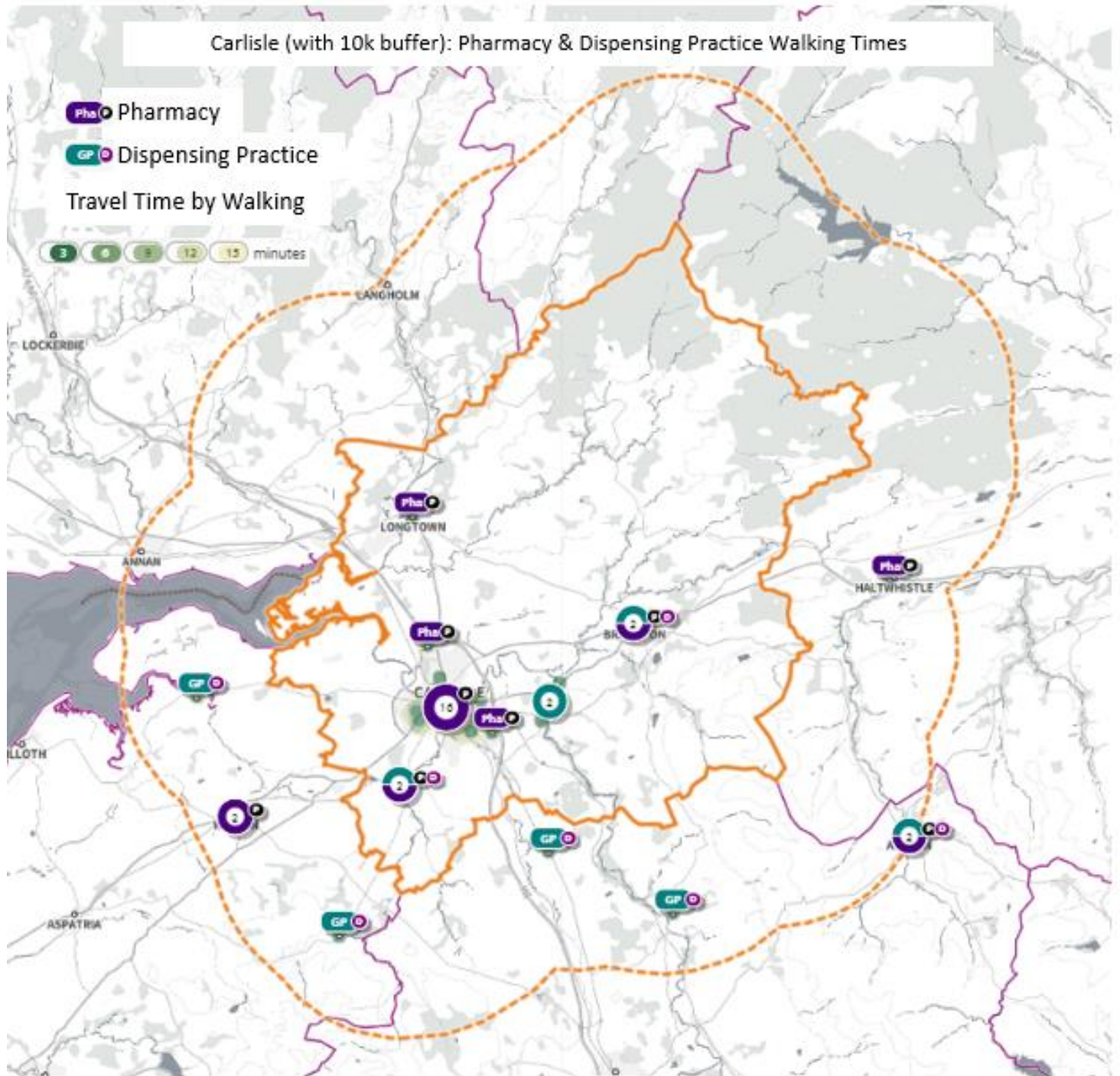
Barrow-in-Furness (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Public Transport Times

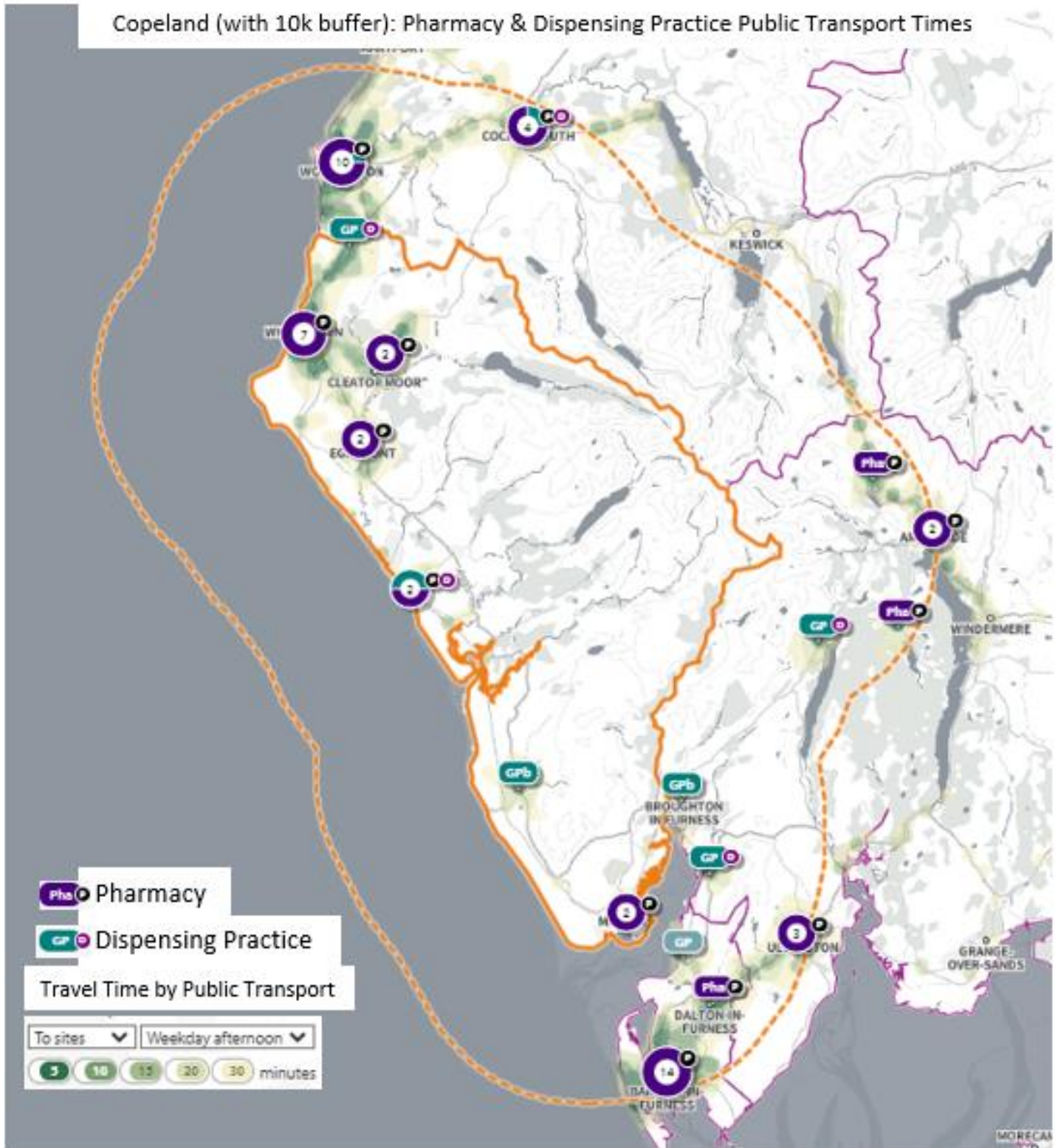
Carlisle (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Public Transport Times



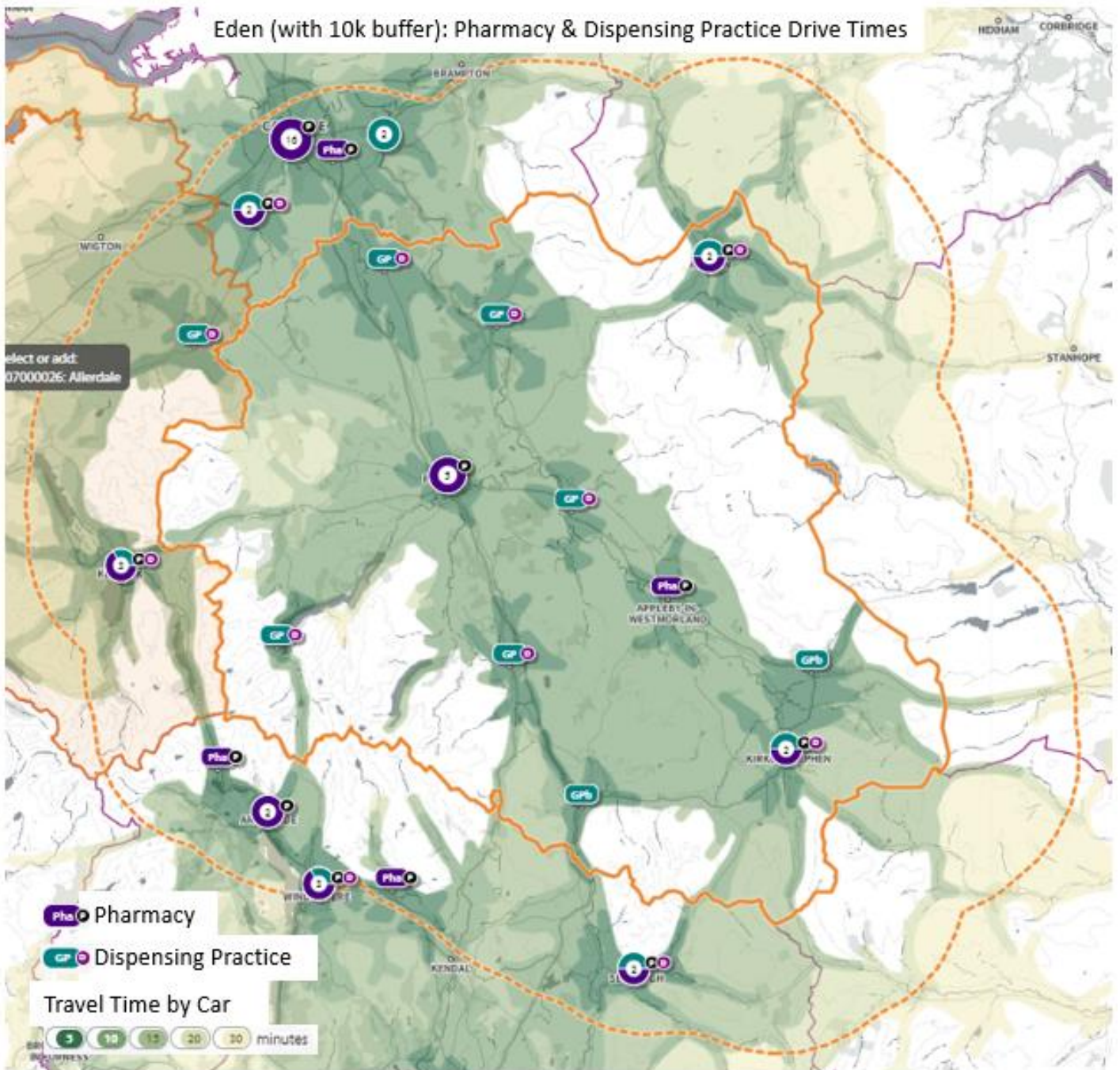




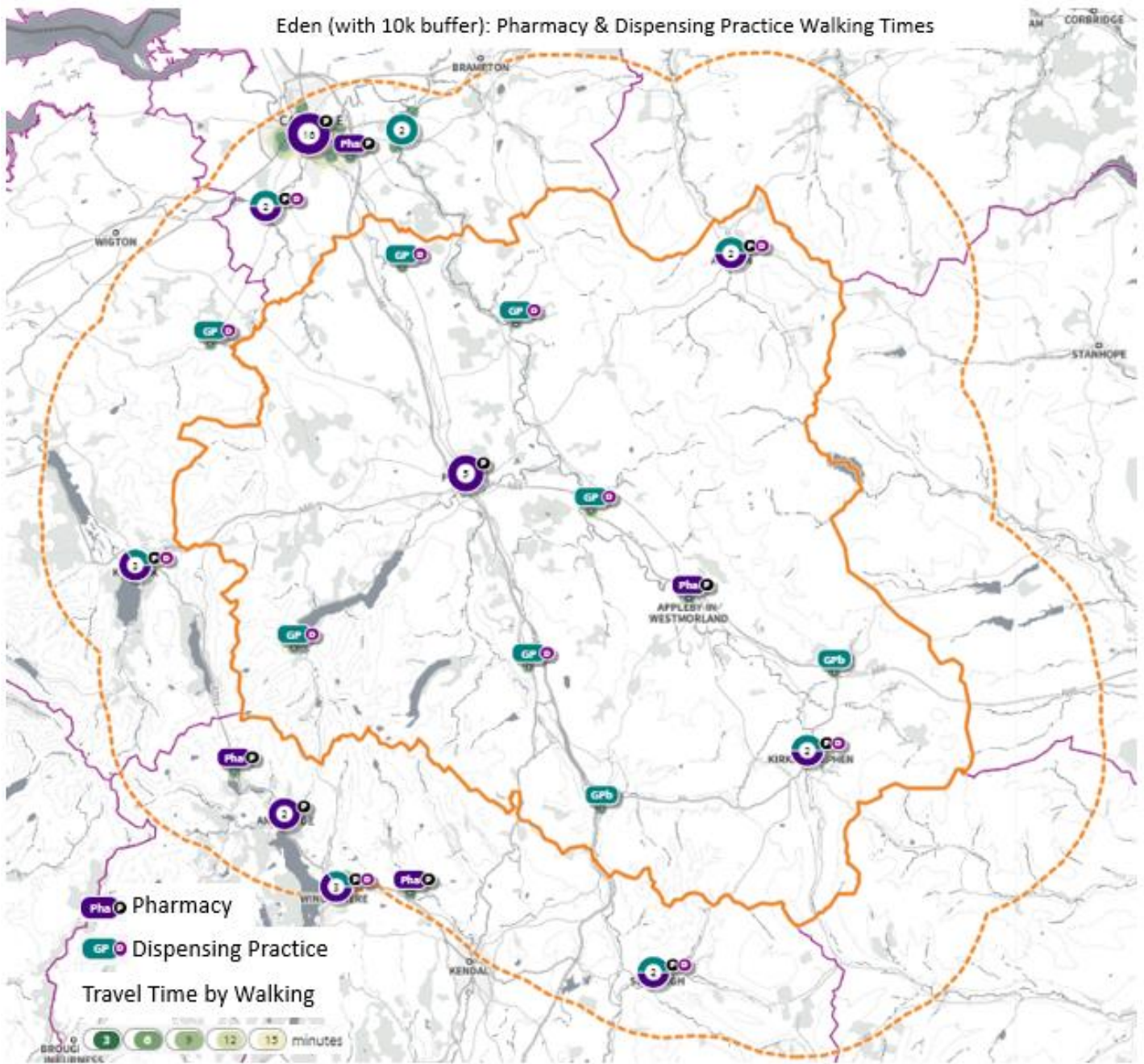
Copeland (with 10k buffer): Pharmacy & Dispensing Practice Public Transport Times



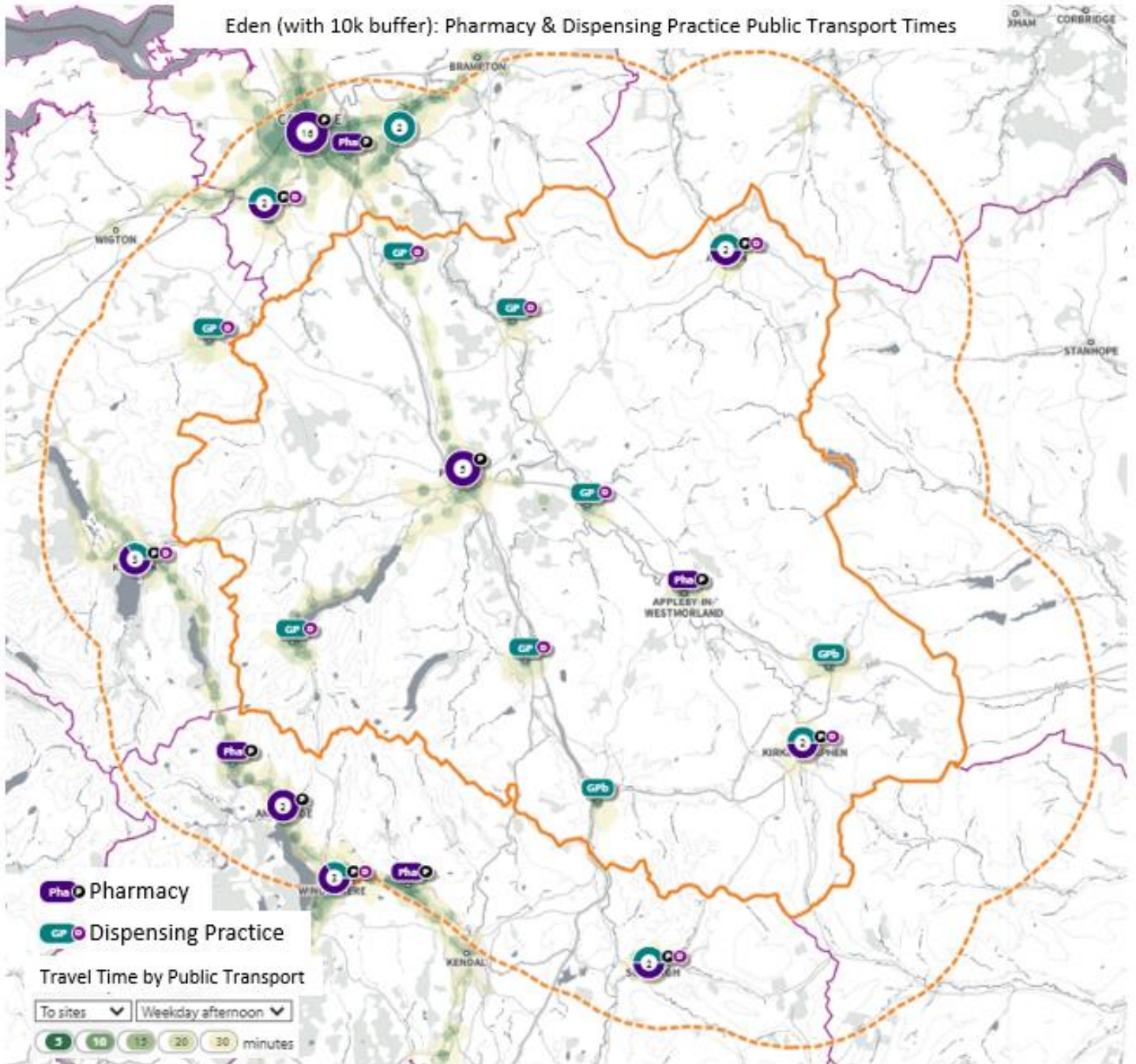

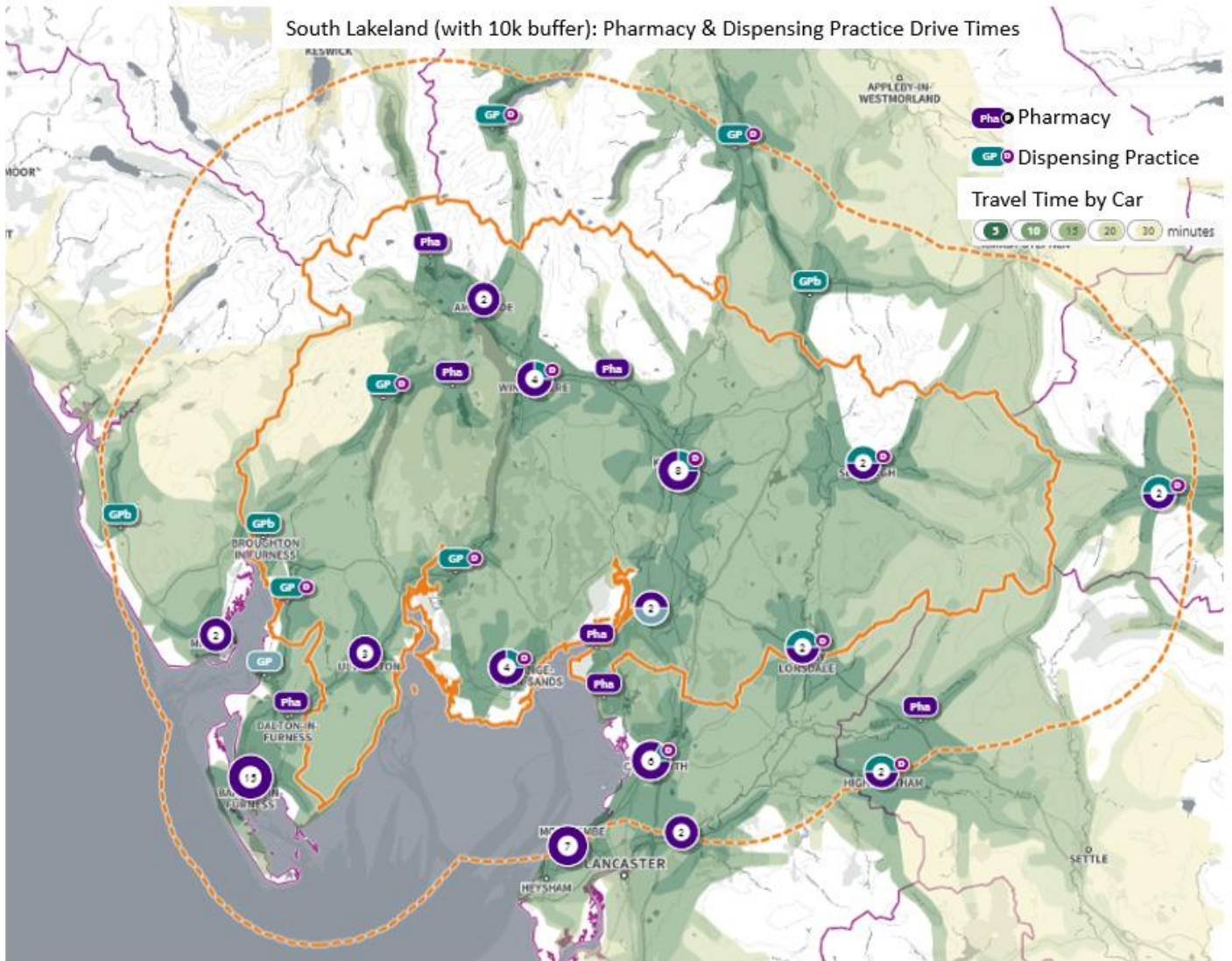

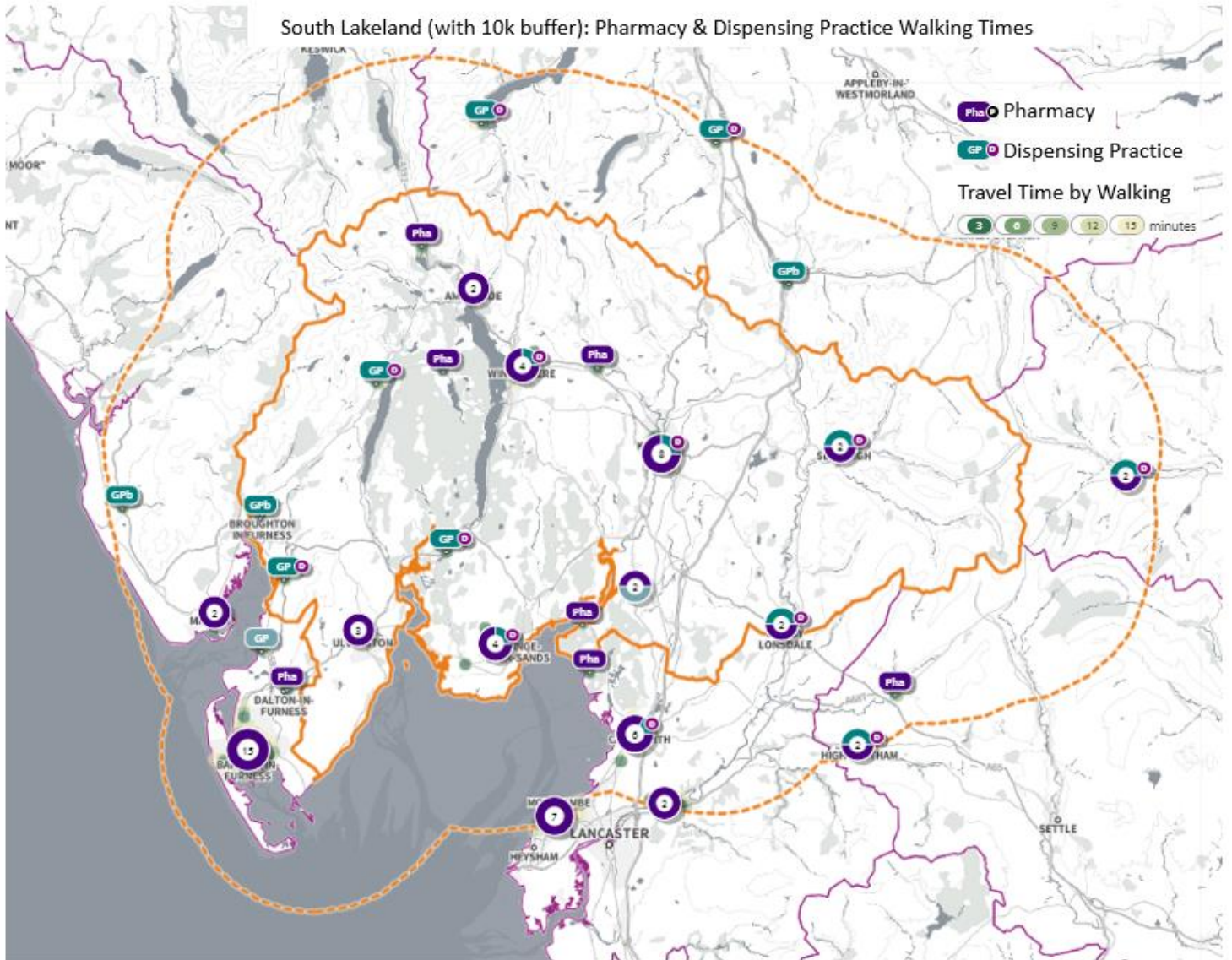
