The following pharmacy has closed:

Boots UK Limited, 8-10 Risedale Road, Barrow-in-Furness. LA13 9RD

The pharmacy provided the following services:

Community Pharmacist Consultation Service (CPCS), Flu Vaccinations, New Medicine Service (NMS), Healthy Living Pharmacy, Emergency Hormonal Contraception (EHC), Stop Smoking Service, Opioid Substitution Therapy (OST) Supervised Administration, Minor Ailment/Think Pharmacy First, Paediatrics Minor Ailment Scheme- under 18 years of age

These services were provided at the following times:

Monday to Friday 9am to 6.30pm; Saturday 9am to 5.30pm (Sunday Closed)

The pharmacy closed on:

3 February 2024

The closure of this pharmacy would not create a gap in pharmacy provision within the Risedale and Roosecote area of Barrow-in-Furness.
